


Daylight Hour Origami Sun






1. Cut the paper into a square along the dashed line.



2. Fold the paper in half.



3. Fold it again into quarters, joining the edge of the paper to the middle crease. Unfold.



4. Rotate the paper and repeat. Your paper should now have 8 vertical and horizontal creases.



5. Turn the paper over.




6. Fold the corner into the middle and unfold.




7. Repeat on all four corners.



8. Turn the paper over and cut the paper along the dashed lines - from the edge to the first crease on all sides.



9. Fold one edge horizonally, unfold. Then fold it vertically, unfold.




10. Push the side corners inwards and underneath the top flap.




11. Push down to make a small square.



12. Repeat steps 9-11 on all four sides.




13. Fold the edges of the small squares into the middle so they touch the center line.




14. Repeat on all four small squares.



15. Unfold steps 13 & 14.



16. Lift open the flap and fold the sides inward.



17. Push the tip of the flap backwards, making a crease along the back so it lies flat.



18. Repeat on all four sides.



19. Turn the paper over.




20. Fold the corner into the center.



21. Repeat for all points.



22. Turn the paper over.



23. Open each flap and fold it down.



24. Done!
